The massive hunger strike protest of the Kurds, who demand an end to the absolute isolation imposed on Abdullah Öcalan, continues with determination.

Kurdish activist Imam Şiř has been on hunger strike for 152 days in Newport, Wales, demanding the end of isolation said he will continue his fast until isolation is lifted.

Imam Şiř has reiterated his determination in continuing the hunger strike until isolation is lifted. While recognising the visit granted to lawyers to Kurdish People's Leader Abdullah Öcalan is a very big step and success, confirmed that it falls short of ending isolation which is the demand of the hunger strikers.

Şiř reminded to have gone on hunger strike joining the "resistance led by Leyla Guven who had launched hunger strike on 7 November." The Kurdish activist has been experiencing heavy health problems in the last few weeks, as confirmed by solidarity groups in Wales.
